1. General Information

Collegium Masoviense – University of Health Sciences is a non-public higher education institution located in **Grodzisk Mazowiecki, Poland**, offering degree programmes in the field of health sciences.

The University participates in the **Erasmus+ Programme**, enabling international students to complete part of their studies at our institution.

The Erasmus+ Programme supports educational mobility, international cooperation, and the exchange of academic experience between partner institutions across Europe and beyond.

2. Erasmus+ at Collegium Masoviense

Within the Erasmus+ Programme, Collegium Masoviense welcomes international (*incoming*) students who wish to undertake a period of study at the University.

Key features of Erasmus+ studies at Collegium Masoviense include:

- courses conducted in **English**,
 - classes organised in **small groups or individually** in the form of tutorials,
 - recognition of completed courses in accordance with the **ECTS system**,
 - academic supervision and professional support provided by qualified teaching staff.

3. Educational Offer

The educational offer for Erasmus+ students is prepared in accordance with the current study programmes implemented at Collegium Masoviense.

Students may select courses **from one field of study and one level of education**.

Detailed course descriptions are provided in separate documents (*Course Catalogues – Appendices*).

The academic year **2025/2026** begins on **31 October 2025**.

4. Organisation of Studies

- Courses are delivered in line with the study plans approved for each field and level of education.
- The final selection of courses is agreed individually and confirmed in the **Learning Agreement**.
- The number of ECTS credits assigned to each course complies with European higher education standards.

5. Assessment and Recognition of Credits

- Students are assessed in accordance with the internal regulations of Collegium Masoviense.
- Upon completion of the mobility period, students receive a **Transcript of Records**.
- ECTS credits obtained during the Erasmus+ mobility period are recognised by the home institution, subject to the Learning Agreement.

6. Support and Integration for International Students

The **International Cooperation Office (Dział Współpracy Zagranicznej – DWZ)** at Collegium Masoviense provides comprehensive organisational and personal support for Erasmus+ students **before, during and after** their mobility period.

Support measures include:

- orientation meetings and **Welcome Days**,
- a **mentor / buddy system** supporting students during their stay,
- **Polish language and culture courses**,
- assistance with administrative procedures (health insurance, residence registration, legal requirements),
- support in using the student information system, library resources and other university services.

The University also promotes the outcomes of Erasmus+ mobility through its official communication channels, academic events and publications.

7. Practical Information

International students are required to:

- hold valid health insurance for the entire period of stay in Poland,
- comply with Polish legal regulations and University rules,
- follow academic and organisational guidelines provided by Collegium Masoviense.

Detailed organisational information is provided to students individually after acceptance.
